

1. "Integration beyond borders" is an informal network of cooperation between Polish and Georgian NGOs.

- 2. To be a network member is a willingness to cooperate with at least one of the following areas.
- 3. The subject of cooperation are:
- Creation of sports and tourism initiatives
- Activities for young people, especially the disabled
- Support for the development of the third sector
- A joint application for funds
- Exchange of experience
- Promotion of Polish and Georgian culture, traditions and natural resources, wildlife
- Joint implementation of the projects
- 4. The formula of the initiative "Integration beyond the borders" is open to accepting new members
- 5. Accepted a simple procedure for the reception of new members to the network:
- -by sending attached form to the Leader of the network, Viribus Unitis Foundation
- -positive recommendation of two existing members of the network
- -signing declaration of cooperation
- 6. The network can evolve into a federation or union of associations
- 7. Supporting the network is voluntary and free of charge.
- 8. The members of the network are not collected membership fees
